Camp Erin Las Vegas is a three-day overnight camp for children and teens, 6 to 17 who have experienced the death of someone close to them. Facilitated by professional staff from Nathan Adelson Hospice and trained volunteers, Camp Erin is offered free of charge to children and teens throughout Southern Nevada.

At Camp Erin, children and teens have an opportunity to be around other children and teens who have experienced similar losses. They participate in fun activities (archery, rock climbing, and arts and crafts) as well as activities designed to help them understand and process their grief.
